Auto crimes are crime of opportunity. Thieves can easily enter a vehicle. They prefer the ones that are unlocked. Increasingly, thieves are using personal and financial information stolen from vehicles to commit identity theft.

Firearms that are stolen from an unattended vehicle and are not secured are likely to be used in a crime.

By following the #9PMRoutine you are taking steps to protect your property, your identity and you're helping lower the crime rate.

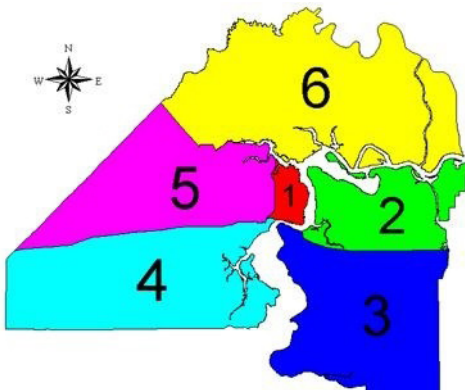
CRIME MAPPING
